Wales' tech ecosystem calls for big investment boost to build on 2021 success

In light of the fast growing Welsh tech scene, Tech Nation's Chair, Board, and Executive Team visit Tramshed Tech in Cardiff to meet Wales' scaling tech businesses

- Venture capital investment in Cardiff reached a recent high in 2021 of \$71.5mn, up from \$63.4mn in 2020.
- Cardiff is home to a sizable startup and scaleup population - 206 tech companies, compared to 232 in Liverpool, and 131 in Bath.
- The combined value of tech startups and scaleups in Cardiff was \$1.3bn in 2021, up from \$638mn in 2018, a 103% increase over the four year period.
- Tech Nation, the leading growth platform for UK tech scaleups, celebrates a number of Welsh tech success stories from it's alumni network, including:
 - Fintech firm, [Yoello](#): developed a new product to serve the hospitality industry during the pandemic and saw very fast growth, raising approx £2.7mn in 2021.
 - Fintech firm, [Delio](#), raised a total of \$15.5mn through backing from Octopus Ventures, one of Europe's most active venture capital investors, and additional investment from early-backers Maven Capital Partners.
 - Another fintech, [CoinCover](#), which combines security technologies with insurance to shield digital assets for crypto companies and individual investors, raised £5mn in June 2021.
 - Net Zero tech firm, [Sero](#), tackling one of the greatest challenges of our lifetime, climate change, raised £5.5mn earlier this year.
 - High growth company [AMPLIFYFI](#) raised £4mn in 2020, and [Veeqo](#) has just been [acquired by Amazon](#) in light of the e-commerce boom.

An established Chair, Board Director, mentor and investor to many digital businesses and entrepreneurs, Stephen is passionate about building a thriving, diverse UK tech ecosystem, with strong social purpose, that creates opportunities for everyone and solves pressing socioeconomic challenges on a regional, national and global scale.
